Polo School Pricing / Summer 2023

Welcome to Brandywine Polo's 2023 Polo School. This year the polo school will be managed and taught by Ata & Oliva Alonso who have been in the sport of polo for years teaching at clubs like the Myopia Polo Club in Boston and the Hamptons. Brandywine Polo now has lights on the arena allowing for after-hours lessons and clinics as well as a new Saturday evening series "Starlight Polo", the first and third Saturday of each month, beginning June 3, 2023. Gate open 5:30pm, Polo starts at 6:30pm. The first 2 chukkers are dedicated to polo school students with Ata & Olivia designating who plays.

Polo Lessons

All skill levels encouraged. Horse, tack and mallet provided unless student provides. Wear your own helmet (if available), riding boots, half chaps, arrive early and sign liability release prior to lesson.

- **\$150 Private Lesson, 1hr Per Person / Horse Provided**
\$80 Private Lesson, 1 hr Per Person / Your Horse
- **\$120pp Group Lesson, 2hrs, Max 4 Students**
\$75pp Group Lesson, 2hrs, Max 4 Students, Your Horse
- **\$200pp Orientation to Polo (OTP)**
Minimum 9 students, OTP is a 2hr emersion into the sport of polo. Students learn team strategy, polo swings and have a group lesson in the arena on a polo pony. Horse, tack, mallet, and polo balls provided.

Coaching League

The Coaching League is designed to advance your polo to the next level, with instructional chukkers in a team like setting. To participate in the Brandywine Polo School's Coaching League, a student must first join as a member of the Brandywine Polo Club, then join the Polo School's Coaching League either by the 1 month, 2 month or 4-month price points. Coaching League is in the arena and or on a grass field held Tuesdays 6pm, Thursday 6pm and Saturday 10am, each session is 2 chukkers, horse included in price. You must own your own helmet, and be a member of the USPA, preferably listing Brandywine Polo as your affiliated club.

Horse Boarding

Full Care Board is available from polo school managers, Ata & Olivia Alonso, May 15 – Oct 22, 2023. You will first need to rent a dry stall / paddock from Brandywine Polo, then arrange Full Care Boarding with the polo school managers. Full care boarding includes grooming, tacking for polo, exercise, feeding, shavings, and transport to Walker Field for Wednesday practices if applicable. Full board does not include shoeing and vetting.

Brandywine Polo Dry Stall and Paddocks – Payment to BPC

- Seasonal Dry Stall (With Shared Paddock) \$1,000 per horse
- Seasonal Dry Stall (Paddock Not Included) \$750 per horse
- Seasonal Tack Room, When Available \$500 each
- Stall Security Deposit \$50 per horse
- Monthly Dry Stall \$300 per horse
- Monthly Shared Paddock \$125 per horse
- Monthly Shared Paddock Security Deposit \$50 per horse

Note: Shared Paddocks only for horses stabled in a stall at Brandywine Polo. All stalls and paddocks assigned by polo club manager.

Polo School Boarding – Payment to Ata & Olivia Alonso

- 1-Month Full Care Boarding, Per Horse \$1,500
- 4+Horses, 1-Month Full Care Boarding Per Horse \$1,200

Other

- **1-Month Intense Polo Training \$3,000**
 - Includes 1-hour private lesson Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, plus Coaching League Chukkers Thursdays 6pm and Saturdays 10am. Polo school horses provided unless student prefers to use their own horse(s).
- **Trail Rides - Horse & Trailering Provided \$200**

BPC Polo School (BPC/PC) – Rules & Regulations

- No free chukkers or stick & ball chukkers to try horses.
- Coaching League: Held every Thursday 6pm and Saturday 10am.
- Unless paying a monthly or seasonal horse leasing rate, all students will be assigned to ride a different horse depending on schedule. Polo Managers Ata & Olivia Alonso reserve the right to assign horses.
- All polo school students or anyone accompanying student, if in the barn area, must sign a BPC 2023 Liability Waiver prior to lesson or being in stable area.
- All polo school payments must be paid prior to lesson, including Brandywine Polo memberships, if applicable.
- All polo school students must wear an accredited safety helmet, riding boots or a leather shoe with a heel, half chaps, riding breeches or full chaps when mounted. Client must bring their own helmet, boots/chaps, or the polo school can provide, but only on a temporary basis.
- All Payments must be paid in full prior to scheduled playing month/polo season.
- Playing per chukker does not guarantee the same horse(s) every time. Ata & Olivia reserve the right to match horse and rider for the best possible outcome.
- All prices reflect amount of pre and post work, necessary to prepare all horses for polo.
- Boarding Available: price includes feed, shavings, grooming, turn out, track exercise in groups, tacking for lessons/games and trailer transport to Walker Field for practices on Wednesdays if applicable.
- Boarding price does not include shoeing, vet, short work, training by Ata or Olivia, trail rides, or night watch.
