Seasonal Stabling Options Summer 2024

Brandywine Polo Horse Stabling Options

Stabling at Brandywine Polo is available beginning May 10th through September 2024, and includes a 10'x10' dry stall, tack room rental option for boarders only and one shared stall for hay/shaving storage per each row of stalls at no cost. A current Coggins is required on each horse prior to arrival or before unloading trailer. All equine vaccines must be up to date. A full inspection of your stall(s) / paddock conducted upon arrival, noting conditions. You are responsible for damage throughout duration of stay and must repair or pay for repairs completed by club. All stall mats currently in stalls are property of Brandywine Polo and are to remain in stall(s) at season's end. All stalls include electric, water, manure pit, and manure removal. You are responsible for your own horse, feed, shoeing, vetting and any destructive interactions between your horse and another horse and or human.

Polo School Lesson & Membership Options May – September 2024

Welcome to Brandywine's 2024 Polo School. We are exciting to have Ola Polo LLC (Ata Alonso and Olivia Johnson) managing the polo school again for 2024 and to offer new lesson memberships that include outdoor grass play and Chica Chukker options. Below are lesson prices and lesson membership prices from a step-up program designed to cultivate the beginner/novice student into an intermediate/advanced player who eventually joins the polo club as full playing member competing in tournaments. As a polo student you will learn and advance in the areas of polo horsemanship, swing dynamics, rules, team strategy and field position. No riding experience necessary, all ages welcome, horse, tack, and mallet provided during lessons.

1-Hour Private Lesson, Horse, Tack, Mallet Provided	\$150
1-Hour Group Lesson, 2 Person Minimum, Horse, Tack, Mallet Provided, Arena Only (Limit 5x before required to step-up to Coaching League Membership)	\$130pp
1-Hour Group Lesson, Chica Chukker* Arena Only (Limit 5x before required to step-up to Chica Chukker Membership)	\$130pp

For private, group and Chica Chukker* group lessons students pay Ola Polo LLC directly. Ola Polo LLC accepts cash, check, Venmo (@atahualpaAlonso), Zelle and Square (+3%).

*Chica Chukker is a term coined by one of Brandywine's beloved members who wanted to learn the sport of polo with a group of women at an easier, more relaxed pace. Many of these women and men, are returning equestrians or current equestrians from other horse disciplines. Lesson format sets a singular intention (for example: lead changes, crossing the line, nearside shot, etc.) The first 30mins is a stick and ball group lesson followed by a slower chukker to practice the lesson's intention.

Step-Up Lesson Program

When a student is ready to step-up to the next level of play in their polo training, there are the options to join as an Arena Only Member or an Arena + Outdoor Grass Member. You will need to first join the Brandywine Polo School as a member, then each time you play pay a horse leasing fee to Ola Polo School, LLC. You will also need your own NOCSAE approved polo/riding helmet, boots with a heel and are encouraged to join the United States Polo Association (USPA) as a playing member, listing Brandywine Polo as your affiliated club.

Coaching League Member – Arena Only

COACHING LEAGUE ARENA ONLY is a BPC member-based riding program taught by Ola Polo LLC in the First Bank Arena and is for the amateur player wanting to take their polo to the next level with drills and instructional team chukkers, arena only.

COACHING CHUKKER FULL MEMBER is a lesson program taught by Ola Polo LLC and is designed to take the amateur player to the next level in their polo journey in the First Bank Arena and cultivate their grass game with 1x per week team chukkers on an outdoor grass field.

CHICA CHUKKER* ARENA ONLY MEMBERSHIP is the step-up level from the Chica Chukker* group polo lessons taught by Ola Polo LLC and intended for the dedicated student who wants a consistent training regime. Each **session** (approx. 1hr) will begin with a stick & ball element that focuses on one aspect of polo, whether it be horsemanship, rules, game strategy or the polo swing. Each session will have no more than six students and two time-options.

Each **session** (approx. 1hr) will begin with a stick & ball element that focuses on one aspect of polo, whether it be horsemanship, rules, game strategy or the polo swing. Each session will have no more than six students and two time-options.

Barn Rules

- The number of horses may not exceed the number of stalls that have been rented. No double bunking.
- Renters must adhere to the paddock maximum horse limit set by the Brandywine Polo Club. Since paddock size varies, please see Martin Eddy for exact number.
- Horses may not live in paddocks full-time, unless approved by Polo Manager Martin Eddy.
- Barn and paddock areas should be kept clean and tidy.
- Please turn off lights when not in use.
- Horses are not to be tied to trees, either in the barn area or at the fields.
- NO SMOKING is allowed in or around barns.
- Please unplug any appliances when not in use to avoid any possibility of a barn fire.
- Please dump manure in designated areas only.
- Please do not throw wire, bottles, cans, hay twine, needles, or anything other non-manure items in manure bins. All manure is reused by local mushroom farmers; thus, we are very strict on this policy.
- Only use paddocks that have been assigned to you.
- Park trailers and vehicles in your designated area, per polo manager.
- No dogs allowed off leash on days public attends events on Brandywine Polo grounds. Including off-site.
- No dogs allowed to live in tack rooms.
- No grooms or other humans allowed to live in tack rooms, stalls, barn, RV or car on Brandywine Polo property.
- Please check with the Brandywine Polo Club before adding any construction materials to your tack room, stalls, paddocks or an outdoor shed.
- Please notify Brandywine Polo Club manager Martin Eddy of any problems or items in need of repair as soon they occur.
